

Opportunities for MA Courses and Students at Flat Time House in 2012

Flat Time House has been running a successful education programme since it opened to the public in 2008. We have developed a close relationship with staff and students across UAL running and hosting projects for a wide variety of undergraduate, postgraduate and post-academic groups.

We see the legacy of John Latham and of Flat Time House as encompassing a wide range of ideas and approaches to art and its connections to science, philosophy and language. The 'Event' is central to Latham's practice, most obviously in his film and performance works but also in his paintings, sculptures and his approach to social structures. Latham used Flat Time House as both a place for and subject of discussion and we are keen to see how the house can shape the conversations that happen within it.

Flat Time House provides a unique setting in which to present and discuss work and ideas. In Latham's lifetime it was at once his home, his studio and an exhibition space. We continue this approach with our public exhibition, events and residencies programme.

This year we are keen to encourage more self-initiated projects from postgraduate students and are open to proposals for both one off events and regular activities.

Previous education projects have included:

- One-night performance events**
- One day group exhibitions and salons**
- Lectures and presentation**
- Seminars and discussion groups**
- One-off and regular film screenings**

We currently host monthly meetings of the MFI group, a yearly-recruited graduate crit group, and less frequent meetings of the NOIT school, a research group looking at Latham's work and philosophy.

The spaces available in Flat Time House are best suited for small groups of 10-15 for discussions and larger groups of 20-25 for screenings and talks. Groups have access to wireless internet and some technical equipment and well as to the kitchen.

We are also happy to consider proposals for more ambitious events that can be developed over a period of time and that could feed into our public programme.
